- Between 15-30 years old (as position is tied to federal government funding)
- Experience working in a social research position (e.g., research assistant roles)
- Strong analytical skills
- Team player with superior interpersonal skills
- A love of learning
- Sense of humor

Assets (preference may be given to candidates with the following)

- Experience with program evaluation
- Bilingual (French and English)
- Lived or working experience with diverse communities such as people with disabilities; First Nations, Inuit, Métis communities; Black communities or communities of colour; newcomers; LGBTQ2S+ or other. We welcome and encourage applications from all qualified individuals.

Work environment

Hours
